

Water Garden Dreams

It all started with a dream of a small 8x10 water feature with 2" waterfalls. Some aquatic plants and a few fish. Sounds simple enough! After being rebuilt several times, it finally worked great and gave inspiration to a larger feature with a series of streams connecting two water gardens. Of course it didn't stop there. That lead to a sitting patio and landscaping. More water features, more arbors, more sitting areas and landscaping and a business was born out of the love of water features all on two acres. After 20 years we outgrew the 2 acres and we purchased 8 acres to expand our business. Now after 30 years our son has taken over the business and is now passing on his love of water features. Not saying this would ever happen to you, but it always starts with a dream, an idea of what could be. Maybe it was a place you visited or a picture you saw. You look at your yard and you start dreaming up your very own water feature. It could be as simple as a bubbler rock or vase, a small pond with waterfalls or the popular pondless water feature to a complex series of waterfalls, streams and ponds. Add a sitting area and landscaping and your dream starts taking shape.



What is so great about this is it can be as simple or as complex as you can dream up. Just let your imagination go. You can do all at once or in stages. Turning your dreams into reality whether you have a professional do it for you or you have a passion to do-it-yourself, seek professional advice before you start. It is always best to do it right the first time.

Things to keep in mind when planning and building that water feature of your dreams.

- Location: Just any old place in the yard is not necessarily the best. You want to choose a place that you can see both from the inside and outside. After all there are a lot of rainy, cool, or wintery days, when you want to stay indoors. Why not enjoy it on those days. Add night lighting and it will extend your viewing time even more.
- <u>Filtration</u>: A good filtration system is essential to a low maintenance water feature. You want to filter and turn your water at least once or twice an hour. Running water through filtration makes for a healthier ecosystem. While still waters can become stale and stagnant.
- Maintaining your pond can be simplified: Beneficial bacteria will help break down debris and help maintain crystal clear water, once a week dissolvable pkts are available. Algae is Mother's Nature way of cleaning your pond but there are products such as Pond Balance, Barley straw extract and others that will keep it under control. Fall leaf nets will keep excess leaves out of the pond and De-icers will aide in keeping a hole in the ice.
- <u>Aeration</u>: Any water garden will benefit from adding aeration. An aerator sits outside of the pond and the airstones/diffusers are in the water. They add oxygen to the water for better fish and plant health. Winter simply raise airstones to upper shelf and will aide in leaving an air hole in the ice.

Aquatic plants: Water Lilies and Lotus will provide shading. Marginals (shallow water loving plants) softens the edges of the hard

look of rocks on the edges plus steal nutrients away from the algae. Oxygenators add oxygen under the water and floaters take up lots of nutrients.

<u>Fish</u>: Are for fun! They will eat algae and bugs in the water if you don't overfeed them.

All these thing work together to create a healthy ecosystem. Using the right supplies can make for low maintenance where you can sit and enjoy your pond instead of working on it all the time. Fall is coming and is a great time to install your water feature. Maybe now is the time to make your dream water feature come true.



We have a small stream with waterfall in our front yard decorated with many flowers that welcome visitors. Our backyard features an inground swimming pool with a pondless waterfall next to it. Our main

pond is 15' x 17' x 4' deep with a 17' waterfall. It is home to many plants, koi, and goldfish. We have a variety of different plants surrounding the pond and patio. A newly constructed deck sits between the pond and patio for great viewing. Many different things to look at on the property. All features were built by the owners.

When you dream it, you can do it! We really wanted a koi pond in our backyard, so we took a leap of faith and DIY to come up with a design and built a pond. Our water feature is a 2600-gallon pond full of the

most beautiful fish. We love our koi and goldfish and have been grateful to rehome several from the Fish Rescue Program. We have learned so much through the Water Garden Society. With a water feature complete, our next step was installing a garden train. We just added a pondless water feature with a G-scale train track that includes the Hell's Gate NY and Golden Gate Replica bridges representing both the East and West coasts. The train races through a unique design incorporated into this feature with plants and lights highlighting the entire journey. Come on over. We have plenty of shade and seating to relax and take in the sights.

Our feature came to reality 15 years ago with the developer from Team Green Lawn and my husband, the main developers, along with our family that showed up multiple times to lend a hand. It was

quite a project. First, they constructed a beautiful retaining wall, along with steps that lead down to the larger pond. Second, they built a small pond at the top which measures 6' x 10' along with two waterfalls that flow into a stream that is 16' long and drops 6' into the lower pond which is 12' x 22'. The bottom of the small pond is covered with moss rock, and shines beautifully with the lights hitting it. They also put a bubbling rock at one corner. My husband took an old hand pump and redesigned it so it flows into a bucket midway down the stream. Beautiful flowers and different sizes of moss rock boulders surround the larger pond. There is a larger, bold boulder that sits at the patio edge overlooking the pond, along with a bench so you can sit and listen to the beautiful sounds of the water feature. The water feature is beautifully lit at night, and we, along with the family and friends, enjoy many hours listening to the sounds of nature and the water splashing down the rocks. We have several varieties of lotus and lilies in our pond, along with daylily and water canna. We have much more to learn when it comes to water garden flowers and fish, but are enjoying the trial and error in water gardening.

Our gardens are designed from our favorite vacations: Colorado, Florida, and Wyoming. We have a cottage style garden with hundreds of shrubs, perennials, and trees.

Nestled in the middle is a 35' pond with a waterfall. Annabelle and Oakleaf Hydrangeas grace us with blooms through the summer and fall. There are a variety of Japanese Maples in the front and back yards. Pee Wee Oakleaf and Quick-Fire Hydrangeas give the side color, bursting with white before turning pink. The front is our Colorado; perennials and shrubs thrive on a 40' berm with Aspen trees and boulders. New this year is a waterless feature in the front yard. Our pond is a small scale of a picture taken at Yellowstone with lots of trickling brooks and a waterfall. We have built everything including the pond ourselves. As you walk around the pond, you get different views of all the flowers and shrubs. Every year we add different varieties of plants for a different glow. A fire pit is snuggled close to the pond for those chilly nights being highlighted with the sound of water through the backyard. 





Site 1-I Raymond & Roseann 6907 Metcalf Ave Overland Park, KS Sponsored by R&R Companies

Welcome to our water garden! We constructed a 53' lineal stream ending in a 450-gallon pond in the fall of 2022. We have lily pads ranging in color





from purple to white along with a variety of colorful annuals such as coleus and summations planted in the stream. There are several tropical plants such as elephant ear, canna, lily, and papyrus along with creeping jenny that soften up the rocks. We enjoy several varieties of koi. A large three urn fountain (113' in diameter) anchors the corner of 69th and Metcalf.

- To host a yearly public water garden tour to further these goals.


The purpose of the annual tour shall be to raise funds for community service projects and educational activities.



Past speakers have covered the many aspects of creating and landscaping water gardens, plants and plant culture, fish care and propagation, seasonal maintenance, and water quality, pumps, and filtration systems.

COMMUNITY SERVICE PROJECTS

During the last 31 years, the Water Garden Society of Greater Kansas City has grown in number and purpose. We started with 30 interested people in August 1992 and have grown to over 400 members. In the beginning, we provided information about ponds to our members, and then expanded to the public through our booths at flower, lawn, and garden shows across the area. Then we opened our ponds to the public on tours. In 1994, schools began to ask for our help in obtaining ponds to educate their students in science, art, and environmental subjects. Other not-for -profit organizations wanted ponds to provide solace and enjoyment for the needy, elderly, and handicapped citizens of our community. To date, over 61 ponds have been built for others. Education and maintenance information are provided.

We are extremely proud of what the Water Garden Society of Greater Kansas City has accomplished in all areas of its development. Your support of the Water Gardens 2024 tour helps us continue to provide water gardens and pond education to the community.

I started water gardening a couple of years ago and it sort of became attached to me. My water gardens consist of a 6' x 9' x 1.5' inground pond and a 400-gallon above-ground pond. In addition, there are 100-, 150-, and 300-

gallon tanks with lotus, lilies, hyacinths, many other aquatic plants, and hardy goldfish. Added bonuses include a rose garden, butterfly garden, and vegetable garden. The main cave area is covered with a 10' x 20' canopy where you can relax with smooth jazz music, water misters, and fountain sounds all surrounded by a multitude of potted plants and trees. Creation and construction of this backyard botanical garden and small park was singlehandedly accomplished in six months in 2022 with constructive criticism from fellow Water Garden Society members. Unique features are a 300 pound four-foot-tall gnome named Big, greeting visitors at the entrance gate; 30 whimsical gnomes guard the features; various wind chimes and whirlybirds; a greenhouse and a hoophouse/sauna. Visitors can be seated and relax in the shade of four sun shelters. At night, the grounds are illuminated with numerous solar lights.

Since we were on the tour last, we have redone the two koi pond waterfalls, added a selfcleaning above ground Oase water filter, and increased the koi pond to 6000 gallons. The goldfish pond contains comets,

shubunkins, and goldfish ranging in size from six to 15". The goldfish allow for water lilies and other plants to not become koi food. The new filter cleans the 6000-gallon koi pond which is then sent through a 4' waterfall into the goldfish pond and spills into an 8' bog/stream back to the koi pond. The high-volume filter keeps both ponds crystal clear and can handle high fish loads in both ponds. Both ponds set in all-day sun locations.

The koi pond contains over 120 koi in basically every color in both straight fin and butterfly varieties

ranging in size from six inches to three feet. Large Thalia seems impervious to hungry koi and thrive in the pond. Two waterfalls feed the pond and the pond encircles a fire pit with seating for 10 that can only be accessed by a three-foot rock slab that goes over the pond. The actual fire pit is a tree stump that is gas fed. Since both ponds had to go into a rather small, fenced area in an established yard, we decided to go with stained concrete rocks. This also allowed us to be more creative in pond design and made access to the area much easier on existing grass.

Both ponds contain 12 underwater Oase color changing lights and sit beside a pool. The ponds and the pool are part of a 700 square foot raised patio that overlooks Lake Winnebago. In addition to pond and pool lights, there are numerous plant and path lights, up lit tree lights, and a glass dock that illuminates at night in Chiefs red. All lights come on automatically at night to light up various parts of the yard and water. The yard landscaping consists of numerous day lilies and hydrangea.

The ponds sit about 50' from the dock/shoreline that at any given time can have one to three herons fishing for meals. Another advantage of the concrete ponds was to try to predator-proof the ponds as much as possible and, so far, no problems.





Paver stones create a walkway that encircles the entire yard with a bench and, for the adventurous, there is a walkway that runs through the middle of the water feature.

This pond concept was the result of a vision. It began as a fire pit in a grove of trees in a squishy backyard. Built in 2006 and expanded in 2019, the 12' x 15' pond has a stream

and a meandering waterfall. The pond area includes a raised flagstone patio with a stacked stone fire pit. This is definitely not the Gardens at Versailles, nor is it meant to be. The goal was to create an environment that could have evolved naturally. There are koi and goldfish, some purchased some rescued, water plants and rocks, lots of rocks, some that are water features of their own. The yard has several garden rooms, including a shade/fern garden, pollinator/butterfly area and a gooseberry patch among others. There are many native plants and trees. Some of the latest to be added are two varieties of Buckeye and a baby paw paw tree. The yard qualifies through the National Wildlife Federation as a Certified Wildlife Habitat. If you do not expect manicured, but prefer natural, you will not be disappointed and may be pleasantly surprised. The reconstructed water wheel, actually used in a grain mill in another era, is still running. A handmade windmill was added in 2023. The windmill and other yard tchotchkes and "yard art" are the results of too many estate sale visits. Please be considerate of mailboxes and driveways while parking on the cul de sac. We love dogs but ours will not be allowed out so please do not bring yours.

While here, keep an eye open for our resident spotted leopard frogs, toads, tree frogs, 5-lined skinks, common backyard birds, in-season migratory birds and, of course, goldfish. Non-native Aquatic Life and Plants Damage Our State's Rich Biodiversity

Missouri and Kansas State Conservation Departments are educating the public about the many perils of dumping goldfish and other non-native exotic pet fish into public waterways. Non-native fish are highly adaptive and can cause significant problems for the survival of native species, destroying the delicate balance of the area's biodiversity. The introduction of non-native aquatic species can reduce food supplies and destroy the habitats of native species, thereby reducing the variety of native fish in our public waterways. Dumping exotic fish and other aquatic pets can also spread exotic diseases and parasites to our native species. African clawed frogs, Chinese mystery snails, goldfish, arrowanas, and pangasius, are some of the worst offenders.



The dumping of non-native plants into the water ways can reduce the quality of our water sources. They can clog water lines and intakes and damage power generating facilities. Because these plants can clog lake outlets, they can increase the risk of flooding surrounding areas.



and succulent garden offset a lush green lawn. But don't stop. The back yard invites you to explore further.

Our backyard is arranged in Japanese Zen fashion so that a guest must walk the paths in order to experience all of the features, some of which are otherwise hidden. A waterfall cascades into a shallow pond that feeds into two streams encircling an open gazebo feature and then converges into a larger lower pond, where waterfalls plunge into an even larger pond with goldfish and waterlilies. The gazebo contains two relaxing macrame swing hammock chairs and multiple comfortable sitting bench chairs. Water from a faucet on the house can be turned on to pour into a dry river bed that flows into the larger pond to replenish water as needed. 



The new filters are behind a custom bamboo screen flanked by cherry bushes. The pond also features a water jet system shooting across the pond to help with aeration and predators, all under the massive cedar pergola. Several smaller patios surround the pond with small sitting areas to enjoy the pond from many views. Breaking over the back yard retaining wall is a pond -less waterfall nestled in amongst the potato vines and petunias. Don't forget to look for the many turtles and say 'Hi' to Thomas as you walk down the stairs to get to the back patio.




